Dear Councillors,

The LBSA would like to approach the council with a proposal for the use of some of the land at Brynhyfryd Park - or Ca' Pown'.

We've done some research of land owned and maintained by the community council, and feel this is one key area that could be better utilised by allowing the association to make some changes. We feel that could easily be transformed into a junior sports playing field.

The aerial photograph shows a 60m x 40m footprint - ample space for a field to be marked for ages up to Under 11, for both rugby and football use. The outlined area is on a slight gradient but we view it as another option to ease the burden on the overused park field and to keep games away from the cricket outfield. It could also be utilised in summer for preseason training for older age groups.

The obvious obstruction is the footpath running through the land and across the corner of the proposed playing field. Redirecting the path around is what we propose and we hope the community council will agree that this is an efficient use of resources in order to benefit a large portion of the junior playing community.

Immediate beneficiaries would include the 6 rugby teams (U6 to U11s) on Sunday mornings, and 5 football teams (U7 to U11s) on Saturday mornings - that's about 140 children.


