Thank you for requesting feedback on your application. As we mentioned in our previous contact we receive many more applications than we are currently able to fund. Regrettably, yours has missed out this round.

Your application was strong in demonstrating the need for the funds, as it is mentioned in the Expression of Interest, the local council cannot afford to pay for those improvements that will facilitate the access to the park and playing zone.

The assessor noted that your application would have been further strengthened by having applied to our Postcode Local Trust, which could have more suitable theme for this sort of project.

You are welcome to apply for the next funding round for Postcode Community Trust. Please be aware that there are other trusts that provide project-based funding from the players of the People's Postcode Lottery such as People's Postcode Trust and Postcode Local Trust.
